





Proceedings of the 2nd Riga Readings in Social Sciences (RRSS)

Instructions to authors The conference proceedings publishes only original scientific papers. Papers are published in English. Manuscripts should have abstracts (including 3 to 5 keywords). The author is fully responsible for the originality of the paper. Papers should not exceed 15 000 characters (without space) (including tables, references, and figure captions). Manuscripts have to be spell checked. The author's declaration that the paper has not been published anywhere else should also be enclosed. The Board of Editors decides on the publication of papers, taking into account reviews, scientific importance, and manuscript quality. All papers should be submitted by e-mail (<u>rrss@lu.lv</u>). The manuscript submission deadline: January 5, 2019.

Copyright. The journal is protected by copyright held by the publisher after the manuscript has been accepted for publication. No part of this publication may be reproduced, stored, or transmitted in any form or by any means, without the written permission of the publisher.

Manuscript layout. MS Word editor should be used for creating the text (font Times New Roman) type size 12 font, 1.5-space, MS Word (.doc format). If any abbreviations are used in a paper, they shall be explained appropriately when they are used in the text for the first time. It is not advisable to use any abbreviations in the paper title or in the abstract. Paper title should be clear. **Abstract** is a short summary of the whole paper including an outline of the objective, method, results and conclusions of the paper. It should describe all essential facts of a scientific paper. 3 to 5 keywords must be included. The abstract should not exceed more than 200 words.

Introduction should outline the main reasons why the research was conducted, demonstrate knowledge of the subject as described by a brief review of literature.

Material and Methods. All research material and methods should be described in detail in this section.

Results and Discussion. Results obtained from the research should be presented textually, graphically or in table-form and the author should comment on the results.

References. References in the list are arranged in alphabetical order by the surname of the first author. All references should be formatted according to APA (American Psychological Association) style. In text citations should be used. They consist of the surname(s) of the author(s) or editors and the year of publication and page number (Author, Year, X p.).

For books: Author, A. (Year). Title of work. Location: Publisher.

For periodicals, magazine and newspaper articles: Author, A. (Year). Title of article. *Title of Periodical, volume number* (issue number), pages.

For Web sites: Author, A. (Date). Title of document/article. Retrieved from http://xxxxxxxx

Information about the author: first name and family name, author's affiliation and institution, postal and e-mail addresses, telephone, e-mail, scientific interests.
